





Check the box on intelligent transparency

Trustworthy communication of uncertainty

- Intelligent transparency: accessible, intelligible, useable, assessable
- Be confident about uncertainty
- · Listen to audiences, and test all outputs
- Vigorously pre-empt misunderstandings
- 'Star-ratings' for underlying quality of evidence?
- Work closely with communication professionals and journalists

Protocol consultation

Public consultation: sugars in food



EFSA is seeking feedback on the approach it plans to take for its upcoming assessment of dietary sugars. The aim of the assessment is to establish a cut-off value for intake of "free" sugars that is not associated with adverse health effects.

EFSA's Panel on Dietetic Products, Nutrition and Allergies (NDA) has drafted a protocol to define the methods for:

- collecting data (i.e. which data to use for the assessment and how to identify and select them);
- · appraising the relevant evidence; and
- analysing and integrating the evidence to draw conclusions that will form the basis of the scientific opinion.

BPA plan ready for new EFSA assessment in 2018



Feedback from a public consultation has helped EFSA to finalise the strategy for its next re-evaluation of the toxicity of bisphenol A (BPA). A "scientific protocol" that transparently details upfront the scope, methodology and information needs before the assessment starts has been published today together with the outcome of the external consultation EFSA held on this preparatory work.

BPA is a chemical widely used to manufacture plastics and resins. EFSA has assessed its safety for use in food contact materials several times, most recently in 2015 when it also committed to re-evaluate BPA toxicity when the results of newly performed studies by the Consortium Linking Academic and Regulatory Insights on BPA Toxicity (CLARITY-BPA project) become available.
